Mr. President,



Nowhere we have witnessed a bitter occupation like Palestine, where a large population is forced to accept an imposed occupation by the occupying forces and its allies. Now, following the one sided proposal of the "deal of the century", Israel, enjoying the support of the United States, is speaking about "unilateral annexation" of the West Bank. A one-sided proposal that benefits Israel, through violating the rights of Palestinians and increases the colonialist power, creating another "Bantustan"¹.

On this basis, while expressing deep concern over the human rights conditions of Palestinians, ODVV:

- Calls upon the international community, the UN General Assembly, Security Council and the HRC as the most important peace establishing bodies to clearly oppose and reject "the unilateral annexation" which threatens international peace and security.
- Calls upon the international community and international human rights and humanitarian law organizations to pay attention to the policies of the occupier and the organized blockade and to take action to identify the fundamental international rights of Palestinians to self-determination and territorial integrity.
- Calls on the international community and international organizations not to recognize Israel and its allies' interests and the disregard of a notable number of international resolutions including 452 (1979) and 2334 (2016), and condemn Israel's failure to undertake commitments under international law and treat Israel as a violator so that the long-time international consensus against Israel policies is not undermined.
