The ODVV Oral statement on Human Rights situation in Yemen, Myanmar and Occupied Palestine

Madam President,

ODVV would like to express its concerns over the human rights situation in Yemen, Myanmar and occupied Palestine.

In Yemen, the Saudi Arabia-led coalition continued to bomb civilian infrastructure and carried out indiscriminate attacks, killing and injuring civilians.

- ODVV calls on the Coalition to immediately cease all acts of violence against civilians.
- We urge all arm suppliers specially the US, the UK, and France to halt arms trade to the coalition.

In Myanmar:

- ODVV calls on Myanmar to respect its Human Rights obligations and prevent all aggressions under article 2 of the Genocide Convention to ensure that the military does not commit genocide.
- We urge Myanmar to take all necessary measures to combat violence against Rohingya.

In Occupied Palestine, settlement building, forced migration of individuals, denial of basic human rights and violation of the right to self-determination by Israel's full control of natural resources is seriously concerning.

The proposed "Deal of the Century", is an annexation plan which disregards the Palestinian rights and adopts unilateral decisions.

- ODVV strongly calls on Israel as an occupying force to fully halt illegal settlement construction.
- ODVV is concerned about Israel's complete neglect of numerous UN resolutions condemning its human rights violations, hence reminds the HRC and international community that Israel's disregard for these resolutions should not remain unpunished.
