Item 4: General debate on human rights situations that require the Council's attention

Mr. President,

We Draw the Council's Attention to the Situation in Yemen. We note the donors' commitment to help about \$1.2 billion to support the United Nations humanitarian aid program to millions of people in Yemen who consist the majority of the population of the country.

Having in mind the devastating situation of Yemeni people, with two third of the people of country in need of humanitarian aid, with people needing food, medicine, shelter and clean water and with millions of children having been dropped out of schools, we call on:

- the United Nations to expand the reach of its humanitarian programs to cover all the people in need.
- the UN Member States and donors to keep supporting the delivery of humanitarian aid to Yemen.
- the UN HC, the UN Special Envoy for Yemen, the UN member States and all parties to the conflict to support a renewed truce in Yemen.
- the countries who have extensively violated Yemeni's rights with bombardment of civilian infrastructures causing irretrievable damages to people's human rights, to seriously stop inhuman operations and crimes against humanity.
- the UN Member States to redouble efforts to strengthen Yemen's undermined economy and to promote peace making and peace keeping procedures.
